    - a. Ecclesiastes 4:5 (TLB) Foolish people refuse to work and almost starve.

- A. Work\_\_\_\_\_
  - 1. Ecclesiastes 9:10a (NAS) Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with all your might.
  - 2. Colossians 3:23 (NAS) Whatever you do, do your work heartily, as for the Lord rather than for men.

  - 1. Ecclesiastes 7:1a (TLB) A good reputation is more valuable than the most expensive perfume.

  - 1. Ecclesiastes 10:10 (NLT) Since a dull ax requires great strength, sharpen the blade. That's the value of wisdom; it helps you succeed.

  - 1. Ecclesiastes 8:6a (NLT) Yes, there is a time and a way for everything.
