## COVID-19 Health & Safety Protocols

### When will VC reopen for in person services?

Our campus is currently open for in person services:

- Saturday at 5 PM
- Sunday at 9:15 AM
- Sunday at 11 AM

### Will online services still be available?

- We are currently livestreaming services for anyone and everyone who is not yet ready to join us on campus at all of our regular service times: Saturday at 5 PM and Sunday at 9:15 & 11 AM
- We encourage anyone who is at higher risk for COVID-19, including older members of our church family and people with underlying health conditions, to continue to join us online

### What kind of changes can I expect from what we usually do on weekend services?

- We are asking everyone to physically distance by keeping 6 feet apart
- We are asking each family group to keep 2 empty seats between them and the next family group
- We are asking each family group to not sit directly behind another family group
- Every other row is taped off in the far left and far right of the auditorium, as well as the stadium seating
- Offering bags are no longer passed during service, but there are a lot of ways you can give:
  - At the kiosk in the lobby
  - Using the offering boxes and poor boxes located inside the auditorium and information center
  - By texting “vcnp” to 77977

- Prepackaged communion elements are available as you enter the auditorium
- We do not hand out bulletins or sermon notes

## Do I need a face mask?

- We are asking everyone attending in person to love their neighbor by wearing a face mask for the entire service
- We have single-use, disposable face masks available for anyone who needs one
- Children younger than kindergarten are not required to wear a face mask
- Staff and volunteers are required to wear face masks

## What precautions is VCNP taking?

- Frequently touched surfaces (door handles, countertops, faucet/toilet handles) are regularly sanitized prior to, during, and after services
- Hand sanitizer, masks, and facial tissues are available in high traffic areas
- We no longer pass offering bags during the service

## How will we be seated in the Main Auditorium?

- We are asking everyone attending in person to practice physical distancing when sitting.
  - Please keep at least 2 empty seats between family groups
  - Please avoid sitting directly behind anyone (keep an empty seat in front of you)
  - Ushers are available to help you find a seat if needed

## Can I receive prayer in person?

Yes! We would be happy to pray for you. In person Ministry Time is now available at the end of every service.

## When will the Children's and Youth Ministries start meeting in person?

- Children's Ministry is currently available for families attending in person at all services
- Youth Ministry is currently open during the Saturday 5 PM and Sunday 11 AM services
