1. "Whoever" -- that means that every single person has the greatest ever!
2. "Believe" -- "I trust myself to Him. I make Jesus the of my life."
3. Making Jesus the leader of your life is the greatest ever!

G. *For God (the greatest subject ever) so loved (the greatest affection ever) the world (all people), that He gave His only begotten Son (the greatest gift ever), that whoever (the greatest opportunity ever) believes in Him (the greatest commitment ever) shall not perish.*

1. "Shall not perish" -- this is the greatest ever!

H. Luke 13:34 (NLT) *“O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the city that kills the prophets and stones God’s messengers! How often I have wanted to gather your children together as a hen protects her chicks beneath her wings, but you wouldn’t let me.”*

1. No college ever said, “We’re the !”
