Why Should I Get Involved?

Each year, thousands of lives are deeply affected by crime—both those who commit offenses and those who are victims. Today, nearly two million individuals are incarcerated across the United States. Most will one day return to our communities, but without support, guidance, and the transforming power of a relationship with Christ, many will fall back into the same destructive patterns. At Vineyard Church North Phoenix, we believe lasting change is only possible through the hope and renewal found in Jesus. Through this ministry, we are committed to breaking the cycle of crime by walking alongside those who are incarcerated and helping them discover a new life in Christ.



How We Serve

Our Prison Ministry is multi-faceted, centered on sharing the love and truth of Jesus Christ through Bible-based teaching, chapel services, and Celebrate Recovery programs. We serve in a variety of settings—including Maricopa County Jails, Arizona State Prison facilities, and the Arizona Juvenile Corrections Facility at Adobe Mountain School—bringing hope and encouragement to both youth and adults. We minister not only to those who are incarcerated, but also to their families, who often feel forgotten or isolated. Through compassionate outreach and the power of the gospel, we aim to bring restoration, healing, and a sense of belonging to those who need it most.



There are meaningful opportunities to serve both youth and adults—men and women—in correctional facilities. Volunteers are needed for tutoring, one-on-one mentoring, discipleship, and more. Whether you feel called to teach, listen, encourage, or simply be present, there's a place for you in this ministry. We're always open to new ideas for how we can better be the hands, feet, and heart of Jesus to those who are incarcerated and to their families who are walking a difficult road alongside them.
